

In the evening, Antakshari competition was held. The volunteers then shared a meal and the program was concluded.

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





The NSS team members went to Narsala village at 10 a.m. in the morning. Volunteers guided the villagers. The volunteers then shared a meal.

A singing competition was held in the evening. The volunteers then shared a meal and the program was concluded.









After the 7 o'clock prayer, NSS volunteers performed the patriotic song Hum Honge Kamayab. This was followed by recreational games and then they were given snacks.


Plastic waste was disposed of from 9 a.m. onwards. The NSS volunteers and the team worked hard for plastic eradication.



The clean-up operation was carried out at 5 p.m. The premises were cleaned. Volunteers had lunch at 8 p.m. and the program was concluded.









Volunteers had lunch at 8 p.m. and the program was concluded.

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





Post lunch, Patang Utsav Programme and Patang Dhaga ani Pakshanchi Kalji was held. Students enjoyed the event.













Nagpur University Nagpur. This workshop was open for all age group people. Family members of students also participated in this online event. Day 2: 22nd June 2021-









Around 30 teaching faculties and 25 students were present on this occasion. The NSS volunteers of the college also participated in this programme.

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



Artificial Nests for Birds Project: 15th January, 2022


After a visit to Shri Maheshwar Old Age Orphanage, Bahadura, Dist. Nagpur, the volunteers shared a lunch.





INTRODUCTION

Department of Home Science Extension Education (Home Science Faculty) of this institution has been performing this activity of donation of essential material and goods to orphanage since last 15 years. VARADAAN, the Vidarbha chapter of Indian Association for promotion of adoption(IAPA), was established in 1970 in Mumbai by a group of professional social workers, lawyers and adoptive parents with the firm resolve that every child has a right to a family and that adoption is the most effective way to rehabilitate destitute children. VARADAAN the Vidarbha chapter of IAPA, Mumbai was established in NAGPUR in 1990. It is registered society, which is also licensed under orphanages and other charitable homes (Supervision and control) Act 1960 and has certificate to do in the country adoption from commissionerate Women and Child development, Pune (M.S.) VARADAAN is the rainbow between two hearts one that asks for love, the other that gives it through adoption".



It has a well maintained 10 bedded child care unit newly shifted to Sitabuldi, Nagpur and is licensed to receive abandoned children from their natural parents Ongoing efforts are made by the team of professional social worker of VARADAAN to place in adoption the infants received at the unit after completing all the social-legal procedures.



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This activity has been undertaken every year from the Academic session 2005-2006, Dr.Mrs.A.R.Rathkanthiwar has extended here full cooperation as a member of the committee of extension activity.





AIM

The main aim of our extension activity is to help the orphan children and to support children in need of care and protection. It is realize that with the help and a few donations for orphans, we can make a huge difference and positive impact in the life of someone.

Preparation of Paper Packets & Donation Run by Department

To sustain the environment and human health, the need for removal of plastic is to be done today, in order to motivate self employment through students guidance, the students of B.A. sem.II and sem. IV have been instructed to create "Paper packets" under extension Activity. As per the requirement, students have made total 2300 paper packets of large, medium and small sizes from newspapers and brown paper. Considering the need of the paper packets, 200 large size (28x22 cm) packets from newspaper, 400 packets of (25x20cm) medium size and 300 packets of (25x15 cm) small size have been prepared for medical shops, Homeopathy hospital and small shops. 500 medium size (16x13cm) packets, 700 small size(14x12cm) packets and 200 very small size(12x10cm) packets have been prepared from bown papers. In this way, the students from B.A. sem II and B.A. sem IV from Sevadal Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur Prepared 2300 paper packets. Out of which 100-200 packets were distributed by the students to each shopkeeper & vendor free of cost. 


