

# **Researchers develop novel UV mortuary cabinet**

THERE are several potential threats of accidental contamination to healthcare workers and other patients and family members receiving the dead body of COVID-19 patient. Even though, standard disinfectants are effective against SARS-CoV-2 but manual disinfection may leave some unexposed area where virus can harbour. Considering all these issues, city-based researchers have come up with novel Ultra Violet (UV) lightbased mortuary cabinet that has

removed the loopholes. DrSanjay Dhoble, Professor of Post Graduate Department of Physics in Rashtrasant Tukadoli Maharaj Nagpur University (RTMNU) said, "To avoid the error and extra level of protection UV light can be used to dis-infect body surfaces or wrappings. Several studies demon-strated the capability of UV light in destroying viruses, bacteria and fung). 
