INDUSTRIAL VISIT AT MIDC SECTOR OF AMRAVTI IN TEXTILE MILLS ORGANISED BY UGC SPONSORED COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF SEVADAL MAHILA MAHAVIDYALA, NAGPUR.

On 2 Feb 2019 a educational textile industrial tour was organized by the community college of Sevadal Mahila Mahavidyalaya Nagpur, Sakardhara. The tour planed for department of Fashion design student and department of Home Science students. College got permission to visit SuryaLaxmi Cotton mill and Verito dove pvt. ltd (garment manufacturing company), which is situated 100 miles away from Nagpur at Amravati road.





After obtaining proper permission for the plant visit from the Plant Manager, we moved further to visit the different sections of the plant, with the group of 10-10 students with our intructors. Mr.Gupta sir instruct us about mill and working process of weaving very deeply. At the beginning we have visited the BLOW ROOM.

The Blow Room is the starting of the spinning operation where the fiber is opened, cleaned, mixed and evened. The Air Machine is subject to suction and the dust is collected in special filters; the material, on the other hand, undergoing contemporaneously, the rotary action of the cylinder and suction along the operating width, effects a helical movement around the drum and exits from the

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side opposite to that on which it entered. It is then transferred by the delivery.



Carding and Draw frame with ongoing process of machine


The carding machine is located in the spinning process between the blow room and the drawing frame. It cleans and parallelizes the fibers. That resulting card web is then formed into a tape and placed into a can. The working elements are taker-in, main cylinder, card top and doffing cylinder. After that we had been experienced with The draw frame machine, this is the machine combining and drawing slivers of a textile fiber(as of hemp for rope manufacture or cotton for spinning) drawing is the operation by which slivers are blended, doubled and leveled. The Draw frame is divided into two parts one is carded yarn and another is combed yarn.

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Lastly we had seen quality control department where YCP Machine (Yarn Condition Plant) is subjected to check the quality of final product . The final product of threads finally checked and monitored through YCP machine with the help of Ultra Violet Rays. Later the threads are further sent to Laboratory for testing the quality of yarn and to categories the same. Then we go for next visit at verito garment factory.\

The plant is manufacturing readymade garments like Pajamas, T shirts and related products, Raw Material of Fabrics: Raw clothes in bulk quantity stored in the raw material section

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Pattern Making: In the process of pattern making, around 3000 layers of fabrics bind and cut together at a Stitching Department: Once the pattern and design finalized, the clothes send further for stitching department. The stitching is being done manually. The stitching process takes care of interlocking, overclocking, elastic placing time to form a particular pattern.

Finishing: excess thread removal, checking of stitching quality and fabric intact. Packaging: the final product being packed in bulk for the supply in this department.

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
