# (Donation to Orphanage)

#### INTRODUCTION

Department of Home Science Extension Education (Home Science Faculty) of this institution has been performing this activity of donation of essential material and goods to orphanage since last 15 years. VARADAAN, the Vidarbha chapter of Indian Association for promotion of adoption (IAPA), was established in 1970 in Mumbai by a group of professional social workers, lawyers and adoptive parents with the firm resolve that every child has a right to a family and that adoption is the most effective way to rehabilitate destitute children. VARADAAN the Vidarbha chapter of IAPA, Mumbai was established in NAGPUR in 1990. It is registered society, which is also licensed under orphanages and other charitable homes (Supervision and control) Act 1960 and has certificate to do in the country adoption from commissionerate Women and Child development, Pune (M.S.) VARADAAN is the rainbow between two hearts one that asks for love, the other that gives it through adoption".

It has a well maintained 10 bedded child care unit newly shifted to Sitabuldi, Nagpur and is licensed to receive abandoned children from their natural parents. Ongoing efforts are made by the team of professional social worker of VARADAAN to place in adoption the infants received at the unit after completing all the social-legal procedures.

This activity i.e. donation to VARADAAN orphanage has been undertaken every year from the Academic session 2005-2006, Dr. Mrs. A. R. Rathkanthiwar has extended their full cooperation and support as a member of the committee of extension activity.

Then personally visited to VARADAAN institute and met Deputy Director, Mrs. Pallavi Padole regarding the requirements of children's need, a list of items has been prepared and accordingly and the items were purchased from the shops and it can be donated in the Institute accordingly.

The infants are more benefitted by our donations. The Deputy Director of this Institute has appreciated our work because we are serving all the items as per their requirements just from 2005-2006 academic session i.e. from 17 years which is utmost essential for them.





#### REPORT ON PANCHVATI PROJECT

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


Fig. Graphical representation of grain donation

#### Goals:


- > To make arrangements of food and water for birds.
