#### **KEYNOTE ADDRESS: (11:30 am to 1:00pm)**

**Dr. K R Vishnu Mahesh**, Assistant Advisor, NAAC, Bengaluru was the Guest of Honour for inaugural function and keynote speaker. He began his

keynote address on “**Documentation and E-report preparation For New NAAC Methodology.**” He has given detailed explanation regarding the Revised Accreditation Framework.

According to the keynote speaker, the three level accreditation processes will be ICT enabled with Student Satisfaction Survey and Data Verification and Validation adding value to the process. The first level would be submission of Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) which is more or less similar to the Letter of Intent (LoI) of the earlier process. Unlike in the earlier system, two specific Windows will be opened in a year for HEIs to submit their applications.

On acceptance of the IIQA, institutions can submit their data /information online in the formats provided as Manuals for Self Study Report (SSR).

Second level, data /information submitted in the SSR will be subjected to an online assessment mechanism/process with Data Validation and Verification (DVV) process after an online evaluation generating a pre-qualifier score.

Institutions securing 30% on the quantitative metrics will qualify for onsite peer review/ assessment. The pre-qualifier scores are exclusive of the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS).



The onsite assessment will be a peer review by visiting teams nominated by NAAC and will focus on the assessment of information provided on the qualitative metrics. The quantitative and qualitative metrics are distributed in proportion of around 2/3<sup>rd</sup> and 1/3<sup>rd</sup> respectively. He has given explanation about all the seven criteria like,

**Criterion I** – Curricular Aspects,

**Criterion II** -Teaching-Learning and Evaluation,

**Criterion III** – Research, Innovations and Extension,

**Criterion IV** – Infrastructure and Learning Resources,

**Criterion V** - Student Support and Progression,

## **Criterion VI –Governance, Leadership and Management and**

## **Criterion VII –Institutional Values and Best Practices**

According to him NAAC has introduced following changes in **RAF**.

1. Introduction of Pre-qualifier for peer team visit, as 30% of system generated score.
2. Introducing System Generated Scores (SGS) with combination of online evaluation (about 70%) and peer judgement (about 30%).
3. In introducing the element of third party validation of data by Data validation and verification DVV.
4. In providing appropriate differences in the metrics, weightages and benchmarks to universities, autonomous colleges and affiliated/constituent colleges.
5. In revising several metrics to bring in enhanced participation of students and alumni in the assessment process.
6. Introduction of data based quantitative indicator evaluation with increased objectivity and transparency.
7. Extensive use of ICT confirming scalability and robustness.
8. Reduction in number of questions, size of the report and visit days.
9. Stages of SSR Preparation and submission.( before, during and after SSR submission)
10. New Changes introduced about key indicators in Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC.
11. Instructions to the Institutions (HEI's) for submission of Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA).
12. List of documents required to be uploaded in pdf format.
13. Distribution of Metrics and Key indicators across all the seven Criteria with examples and weightages.

**DISCUSSION: (1:00 pm to 2:00pm)**

Dr. K R Vishnu Mahesh, Assistant Advisor, NAAC, Bengaluru has actively taken part in the discussion. In this session he has answered all the queries of the participants.



**PLANERY TALK: (2:30 pm to 3:30pm)**

**Dr. Gururaj Dangare**, HOD, MBA Pratibha Institute of Business Management, Pune, was the second Guest of Honour for the inaugural function and speaker of the session after lunch. He has delivered his talk on “**Start up and Incubation centre in affiliated colleges.**”

He said that mentorship is a critical foundational component for building a successful start-up. Research from the Federation of Small Businesses has shown that small businesses that have received mentorship have superior survivability rates when compared to non-mentored businesses. According to him there are five critical elements that every start-up should look for in a start-up mentor.



**Industry Knowledge:** A mentor from the same industry vertical and in the specific area of your start-up would help you understand the nuances of the business and the varied nature of the market. General mentors typically provide generic advice and this, at times, would not be applicable for your start-up. There are cases where a mentor who was considered an innovation stalwart was considered a poor mentor by a start-up that was working in specific niche areas.

**Entrepreneurs:** It always helps if you are mentored by someone who has gone through the process of entrepreneurship and has been successful at it. Mentors from corporate who manage large businesses are fine, but it is a different

ballgame when you need to validate your idea, raise money and steer the company through difficult times. Entrepreneurship is hard and someone who has walked that path can understand the various issues and guide you appropriately. A mentor who has built a company from idea to exit is ideal.

**Network Effects:** A mentor with strong connections in the industry and the ecosystem you are operating in is highly valuable. The mentor has the potential to open multiple doors for you. The mentor could leverage his connections to bring in extended network effects that can provide you with early customer trials, strategic engagements, potential customers, interested investors and many more.

**Chemistry:** You will need to closely work with your mentor; therefore good chemistry between the mentor and the mentee will immensely help. The mentor should empathise with you, help you look at the bigger picture and assist you through the various trials and tribulations faced by the start-up. Depression and blues are common problems faced by young entrepreneurs, and a good mentor can help reduce some of the burden. However, it is good to avoid strongly opinionated mentors. There should be space to openly discuss differing viewpoints and merge on common grounds quickly.

**Visionary & Problem Solver:** Two key elements for a start-up are finding creative solutions to current problems and looking beyond the current daily buzz of the start-up. A great start-up mentor should help you find great solutions for the problems faced by your start-up, like funding, technology, market access or organisation culture. The mentor should help you build solutions to these problems creatively and efficiently, and bring forth his experiential knowledge to tackle similar situations. The mentor should also help you look beyond the daily operational and tactical issues faced by your start-up and help you build a grander vision for it. The mentor should help you look at the evolving technology trends and changing market dynamics help you build alternative revenue streams, and scale and solidify your position in the market.

Overall, be careful and cognizant while choosing a mentor for your start-up. A single mentor may not have all the elements listed above, and therefore you may need two or three mentors with different levels of engagements guiding you. But if you do find a person with all the above characteristics, you will definitely benefit from his or her guidance.


## **VALEDICTORY FUNCTION: (4:30 pm to 5:30pm)**
