OBJECTIVES

- Encourage the most effective use of the resources and services of the Library.
- Faster the improvement of existing Library services activities and communication procedures.
- Provide a basis for discovering new areas of cooperation.
- Initiate new services and joint programme as needed or desired.

FUNCTIONS

- 1. To provide proper organization of the Library.
- 2. To prepare the annual budget and proposal for development of Library.
- 3. To submit the annual report of the Library.
- 4. Every Head should develop the departmental Library.
- 5. Recommendations of Journals in the Library are made through the Library advisory committee. The Journals/Periodicals will be subscribed as per the priority.



- 6. The Librarian should place the order to the publisher as per the recommendations made by head of the departments.
- 7. The Librarian should verify the budget allotted to the respective departments prior to the purchase of orders.
- 8. The book should be marked specifically so as to categories to certain whether a reference books or textbooks.
- 9. Encourage students to optimum use of the virtual classroom and institutional repository in the Library.

POWERS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- 1. All the Heads of the department are empowered to purchase the reference-books/textbooks and books for the library as per the budget sanctioned to them.
- 2. The selection of the books is made in consultation with the colleagues of the department.
- 3. In no case the budget provided for the financial year should be exceeded.
- 4. Mutual adjustment about the funds if any should be done only with the prior permission of the Hon'ble Principal.

During the academic session 2021-22, the Central Library has been enriched with (12,711 Text Books & 375 Reference Books) 13,086 UG and PG books through departmental budget. The total cost of books purchased in this academic year is Rs. 87,869.85/- (Eighty Seven thousand & Eight hundred Sixty Nine rupees & Eighty five paisa only) on grant & non grant basis. In addition to this amount, the college had also provided the fund for subscribing journals i.e. Rs. 61,350.00/- (Sixty one Thousand Three Hundred & Fifty rupees only) and N-list (UGC INFLIBNET) online journals subscription for Rs.5900/- (Five thousand nine hundred rupees only). During this session, the cumulative cost of purchased books and journals is Rs. 1,55,119.85/- (One Lakh Fifty Five Thousand One hundred Nineteen rupees & Eighty five paisa only) and the number of books purchased is UG 155 & PG 62 and Music Project books is 210.

In the Central Library, all the readers can avail the facility of daily **12** newspapers, **14** Magazines and **20** different print and N-list online journals. The maximum budget amount we had spent on the purchase for textbooks, reference books and the journals. Instead of this budget, the college had spent an extra budget for the purchase of newspapers and magazines every month. In the department, we have concentrated on student's orientation, such as optimum use of the reading material, ICT service and other services. Due to the corona pandemic we had to provide useful information and weblink to the students on whatsaap group and through the college website e-Library.

The Central Library department provided the facility of UGC-INFLIBNET N-LIST online journals and e-books service for the students and staff-members of the college. In connection with this, we had provided the personal user ID & password through INFLIBNET center to the interested students and staff-

During the academic session 2020-21, the Central Library has been enriched with (12,476 Text Books & 375 Reference Books) 12,851 UG and PG books through departmental budget. The total cost of books purchased in this academic year is Rs. 75,895.2/- (Seventy Five thousand & Eight hundred ninety five rupees & twenty paisa only) on grant & non grant basis. In addition to this amount, the college had also provided the fund for subscribing journals i.e. Rs. 50,860.00/- (Fifty Thousand Eight Hundred & Sixty rupees only) and N-list (UGC INFLIBNET) online journals subscription for Rs.5900/- (Five thousand nine hundred rupees only). During the academic session 2019-20, the Central Library has been enriched with (11,959 Text Books & 375 Reference Books) **12,334** UG and PG books through departmental budget. The total cost of books purchased in this academic year is **Rs. 90,830.29/- (Ninety thousand & Eight hundred thirty rupees & twenty nine paisa only)** on grant & non grant basis. In addition to this amount, the college had also provided the fund for subscribing journals i.e. **Rs. 61,470.00/-**(Sixty One Thousand Four Hundred & Seventy rupees only) and N-list (UGC INFLIBNET) online journals subscription for **Rs.5900/- (Five thousand nine hundred rupees only)**. During this session, the cumulative cost of purchased books and journals is Rs. **1, 58,200.29/- (One Lakh Fifty Eight Thousand Two hundred & twenty nine paisa only)** and the number of books purchased is **UG 236 & PG 21**.

This year the Library department space is expanded for the students reading room purpose. The college management had provided new space 400 Sq. Ft. for a student reading room and 150 Sq. Ft. space for teaching staff reading room. Due to this library stack room is expanded and more bookshelves will be accommodated for the new books shelving.

In the Central Library, all the readers can avail the facility of **14** daily newspapers, **14** Magazines and **25** different print and N-list online journals. The maximum budget amount we had spent on the purchase for textbooks, reference books and the journals. Instead of this budget, the college had spent an extra budget for the purchase of newspapers and magazines every month. In the department, we have concentrated on student's orientation, such as optimum use of the reading material, ICT service and other services. The total number of **4,067** books had been issued, returned & renewal transactions were done in the department during the whole year. 

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ANNUAL REPORT OF LIBRARY DEPARTMENT

ACADEMIC SESSION 2018-19

During the academic session 2018-19, the Central Library has been enriched with (11,634 Text Books & 374 Reference Books) 12,008 UG and PG books through departmental budget. The total cost of books purchased in this academic year is Rs. 54,987.50/- (Fifty Four thousand & Nine hundred eighty seven rupees & fifty paisa only) on grant & non grant basis. In addition to this amount, the college had also provided the fund for subscribing journals i.e. Rs. 55,610.00/- (Rupees Fifty Five Thousand Six Hundred & Ten rupees only) and N-list (UGC INFLIBNET) online journals subscription for Rs.5900/- (Five thousand nine hundred rupees only). During this session, the cumulative cost of purchased books and journals is Rs. 1, 10,597/- (One Lakh Ten Thousand Five hundred & Ninety Seven rupees only) and the number of books purchased is 242.

The Library department is facing from urgent infrastructural expansion. Unfortunately, due to lack of space for new books shelving, the department could not spend the allotted budget for new books purchasing. Moreover, due to lack of library attendant, it is very difficult to handle the departmental in-house activity, specially, the non-grants students in UG & PG. The department also desperately needs at least two library attendants for the smooth working of departmental activity.

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In the Central Library, all the readers can avail the facility of 14 daily newspapers, 14 Magazines and 25 different print and online journals. The maximum budget amount we have spent on the purchase for textbooks, reference books and the journals. Instead of this budget, the college had spent extra budget for the purchase of newspapers and magazines in every month. In the department, we have concentrated on student's orientation, such as optimum use of the reading material, ICT service and other services. The total number of **8,614** books had been issued, returned & renewal transaction was done in the department during the whole year. In addition to this, we provide the internet facility to UG, PG and Research-scholar students. Lots of the students are using this facility for their projects and other academic work.

The Library department provided the facility of UGC-INFLIBNET N-LIST online journals and e-books service for the students and staff-members of the college. In connection with this, we had provided the personal user ID & password through INFLIBNET centre to the

ANNUAL REPORT OF LIBRARY DEPARTMENT

ACADEMIC SESSION 2017-18

During the academic session 2017-18, the Central Library has been enriched with 11,766 UG and PG books through departmental budget. The total cost of books purchased in this academic year is Rs. 39,070/- (Thirty Nine thousand & Seventy rupees only) on grant basis. In addition to this amount, the college had also provided the fund for subscribing journals i.e. Rs. 54,660.00/- (Rupees Fifty Four Thousand Six Hundred & Sixty rupees only) and N-list (UGC INFLIBNET) online journals subscription for Rs.5900/- (Five thousand nine hundred rupees only). During this session, the cumulative cost of purchased books and journals is Rs. 99,630/- (Ninety Nine thousand Six hundred & Thirty rupees only) and the number of books purchased is 146.

The Library department is facing from urgent infrastructural expansion. Unfortunately, due to lack of space for new books shelving, the department could not spend the allotted budget for new books purchasing. Moreover, due to lack of library attendant, it is very difficult to handle the departmental in-house activity, specially, the non-grants students in UG & PG. The department also desperately needs at least two library attendants for the smooth working of departmental activity.

In the Central Library, all the readers can avail the facility of 14 daily newspapers, 14 Magazines and 25 different print and online journals. The maximum budget amount we have spent on the purchase for textbooks, reference books and the journals. Instead of this budget, the college had spent extra budget for the purchase of newspapers and magazines in every month. In the department, we have concentrated on student's orientation, such as optimum use of the reading material, ICT service and other services. The total number of 7,354 books had been issued, returned & renewal transaction was done in the department during the whole year. In addition to this, we provide the internet facility to UG, PG and Research-scholar students. Lots of the students are using this facility for their projects and other academic work.

The Library department provided the facility of UGC-INFLIBNET N-LIST online journals and e-books service for the students and staff-members of the college. In connection with this, we had provided the personal user ID & password through INFLIBNET centre to the interested students and staff-members of the college for the maximum use of this service. In



view of the students' benefit, the college started the on-line virtual class room facility. Lots of students availed this facility with their faculty member.

This year, the department had organized two Guest Lectures for the students and staffmembers for their knowledge enrichment. ACADEMIC SESSION 2016-17

Current academic session 2016-17 the central Library has been enriched with 11,617 UG and PG books through departmental and UGC budget. The total cost of books purchase in this academic year Rs. 7,450/- (Seven thousand Four Hundred & Fifty rupees only) for Grant basis. In addition to this amount, the college has given the fund for subscribing journals i.e. Rs. 52,010/-(Fifty two thousand & ten Rupees) and N-list (UGC INFLIBNET) online journals subscription Rs.5000/- (Five thousand rupees).
