Floral design for arranging skills can lead to various career opportunities including, owning a floral shop, event planning, art gallery design and much more.

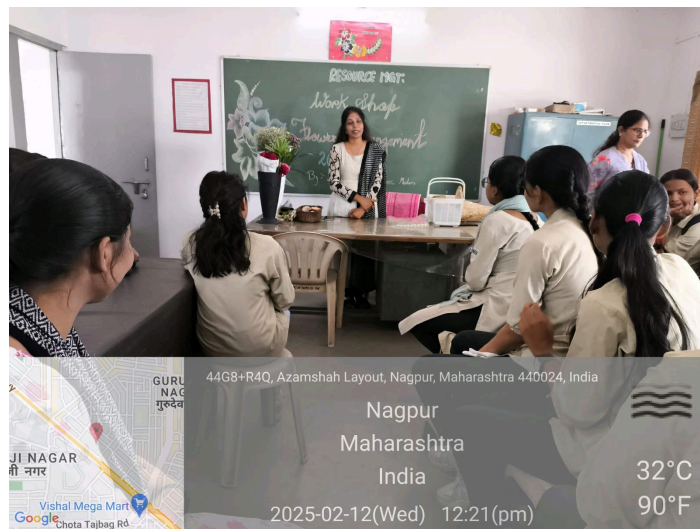
