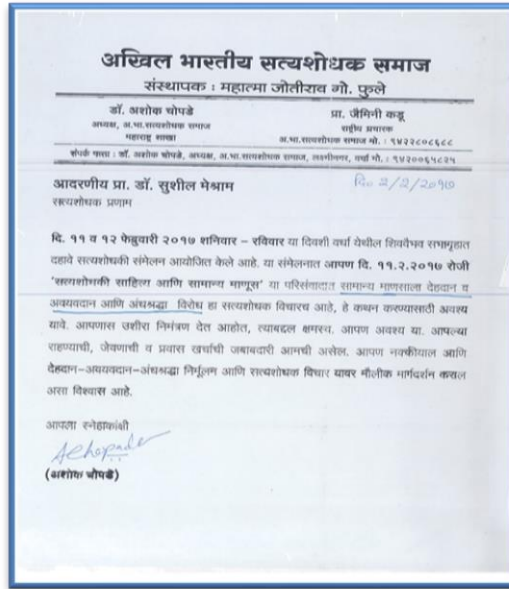

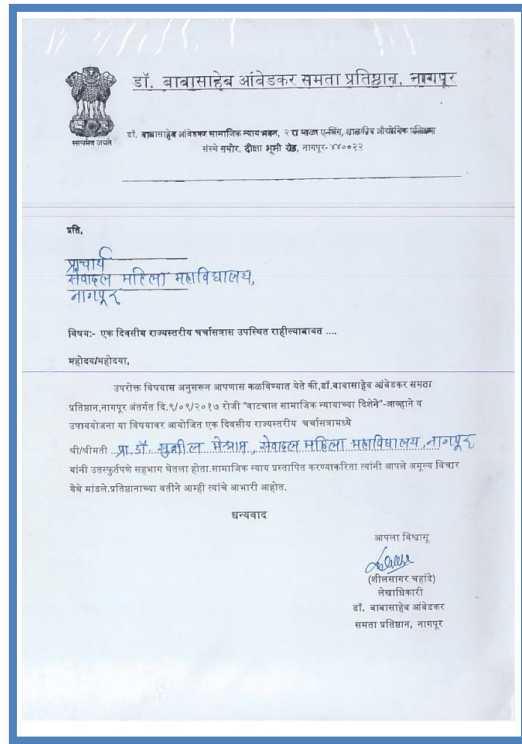

❖ **Co-operation in Body Donation of Prof. Jaimini Kadu: 17th March, 2018**

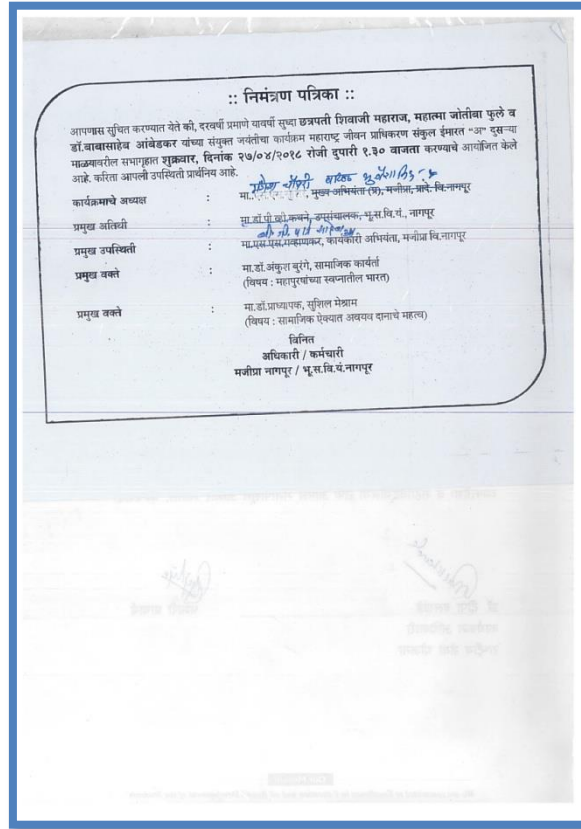

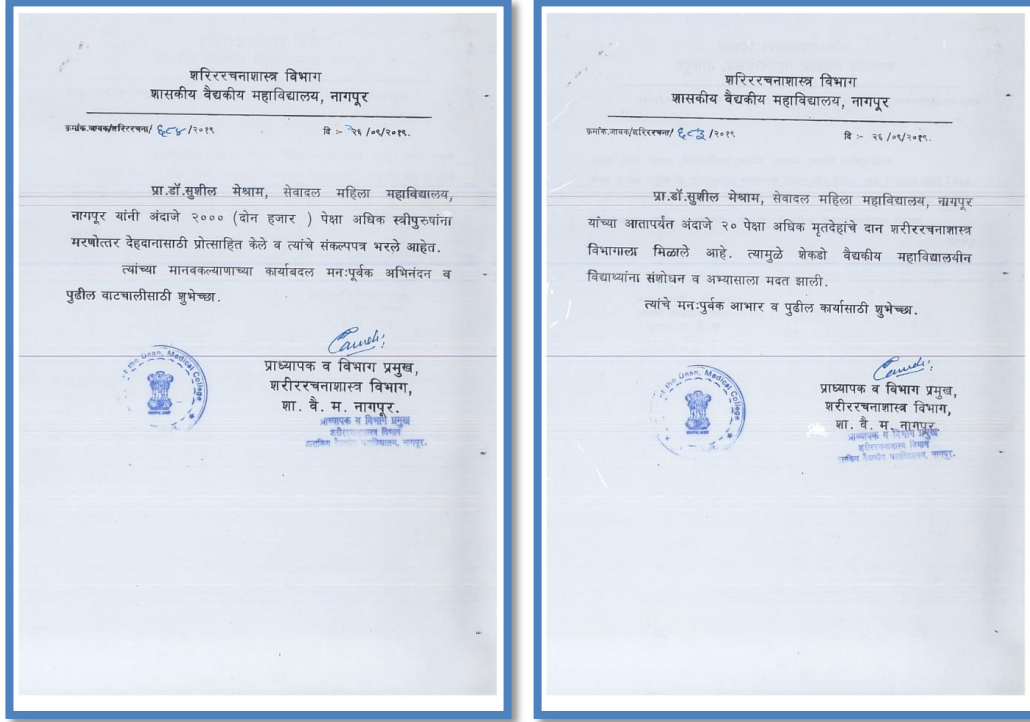

❖ **Eye Donation by Shri. Subhash Soundarkar: 20th November, 2019**

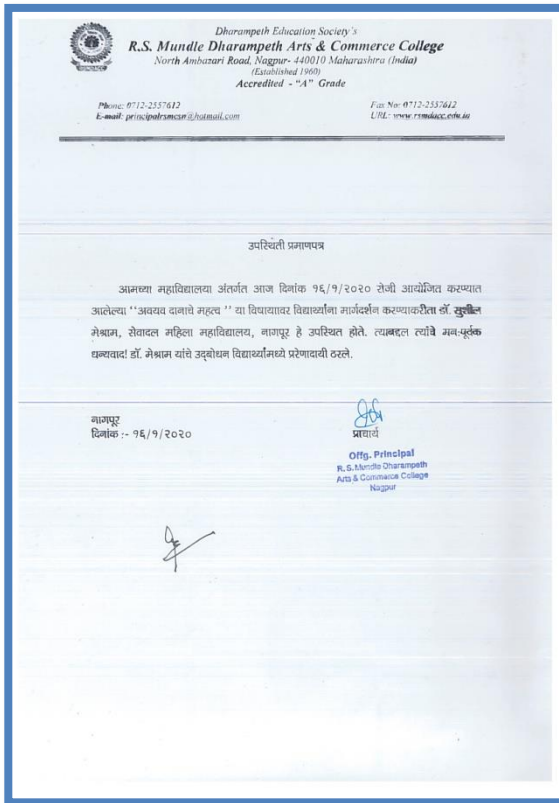

❖ **Eye and Body Donation by Shri Kapurchand Dongre: 17th January, 2020**

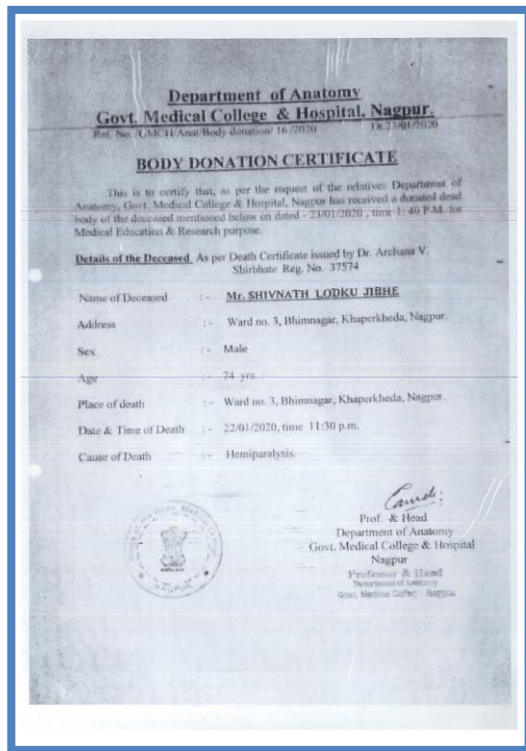

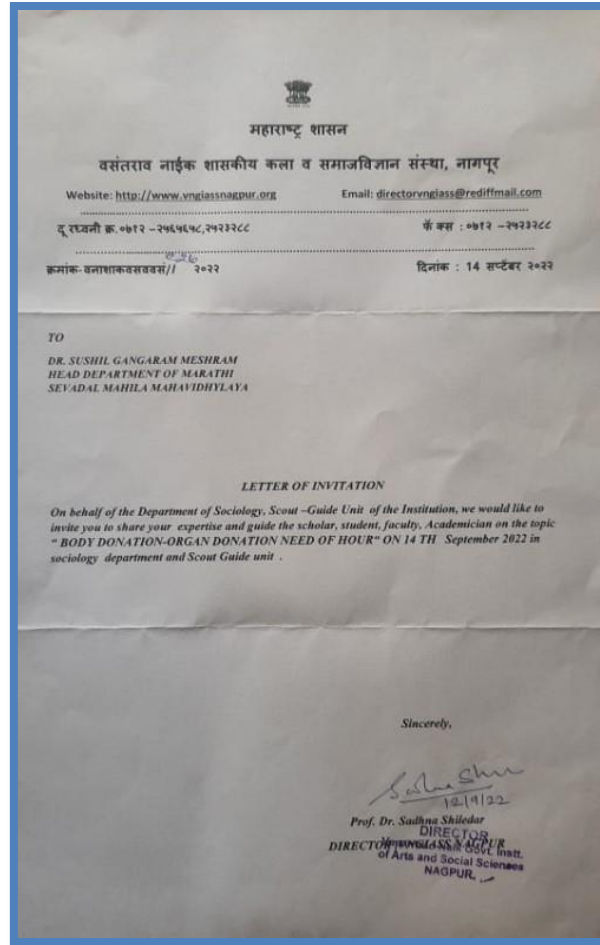


